Your Excellency

I have the honour to acknowledge receipt of your letter of which reads as follows

I have the honour to inform you that in order to facilitate the travel of the nationals of each of the two countries in the territory of the other the Government of the State of Israel is prepared to conclude with the Government of the Federation of Saint Kitts and Nevis an Agreement on the following terms

Article 1

For the purpose of this Agreement Passport shall mean a regular national Passport

Article 2

Nationals of Saint Kitts and Nevis holders of valid national passports, shall be exempt from the obligation of obtaining tourist visas for a stay in Israel not exceeding three months

Article 3

Israel nationals holders of valid national passports, shall be exempt from the obligation of obtaining tourist visas for a stay in Saint Kitts and Nevis not exceeding three months

Article 4

Nationals of Saint Kitts and Nevis and Israel who wish to stay in Saint Kitts and Nevis or in Israel respectively for a period exceeding three months shall obtain the necessary authorisation from the competent authorities of the country concerned

Article 5

Subject to the foregoing provisions persons benefiting under this Agreement shall while in Saint Kitts and Nevis or in Israel comply with the laws and regulations applicable to foreigners in respect of entry and residence, temporary or permanent, and shall not take up any employment, whether paid or unpaid nor practice for personal profit any professional or commercial activity unless proper authority has been given by the respective Government

Article 6

The Governments of Saint Kitts and Nevis and of Israel reserve the right to refuse admission to persons not possessing a valid national passport or lacking adequate means of subsistence or otherwise ineligible under the general policy of the respective Governments relating to the entry of aliens

Article 7

Each of the two contracting parties undertakes to readmit without formality into its territory any of its nationals

Article 8

The Governments of Saint Kitts and Nevis and of Israel reserve the right temporarily to suspend the application of this Agreement except Article 7 thereof for reasons of public order or national security by giving the other Government immediate notice through diplomatic channels

Article 9

If the above proposals are acceptable to the Government of the Federation of St Kitts and Nevis I have the honour to suggest that the present note and your reply in that sense shall constitute an Agreement between the two Governments in this matter which shall enter into force on the date of Your Excellency's reply

The Agreement shall be subject to termination by either Government upon six months notice given in writing to the other Government.



Dear Excellency,

I have the honour to inform you that, in order to facilitate the travel of the nationals of each of the two countries in territory of the other the Government of the State of Israel is prepared to conclude with the Government of the Federation of Saint Kitts and Nevis an Agreement on the following terms

Article 1

For the purpose of this Agreement passport shall mean a regular national passport

Article 2

Nationals of Saint Kitts and Nevis, holders of valid national passports, shall be exempt from the obligation of obtaining tourist visas for a stay in Israel not exceeding three months

Article 3

Israeli Nationals, holders of valid national passports, shall be exempt from the obligation of obtaining tourist visas for a stay in Israel not exceeding three months

Article 4

Nationals of Saint Kitts and Nevis and Israel, who wish to stay in Saint Kitts and Nevis or in Israel respectively, for a period exceeding three months, shall obtain the necessary authorisation from the competent authorities of the country concerned

Article 5

Subject to the foregoing provisions, persons benefiting under this Agreement shall, while in Saint Kitts and Nevis or in Israel, comply with the laws and regulations applicable to foreigners in respect of entry and residence, temporary or permanent, and shall not take up any employment, whether paid or unpaid, nor practice for personal profit any professional or commercial activity unless proper authority has been given by the respective Government

Article 6

The Governments of Saint Kitts and Nevis and of Israel reserve the right to refuse admission to persons not possessing a valid national passport or lacking adequate means of subsistence or otherwise ineligible under the general policy of the respective Governments relating to the entry of aliens

Article 7

article 9

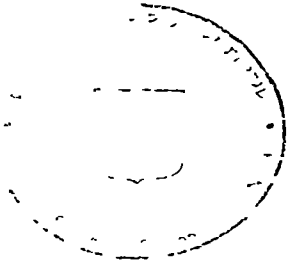
